8 **ORDER**

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10 WHEREAS, Supreme Court Order No. 20-8500-013 required New Mexico
11 courts to cease using CourtCall and other similar services for certain proceedings
12 during the current public health emergency;

13 WHEREAS, the New Mexico Judiciary has developed and refined a number
14 of effective and efficient telephonic and audio-video methods for parties to attend
15 court proceedings at no additional cost; and

16 WHEREAS, in light of the foregoing and the Court being sufficiently advised,
17 Chief Justice Judith K. Nakamura, Justice Barbara J. Vigil, Justice Michael E. Vigil,
18 Justice C. Shannon Bacon, and Justice David K. Thomson concurring;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the use of
20 CourtCall or other similar services under Order No. 20-8500-013 for certain
21 proceedings shall remain in effect until September 1, 2020; and

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
IT IS FUTHER ORDERED that on September 1, 2020, all New Mexico courts shall discontinue the use of CourtCall and other similar services that require the parties to pay a fee for the service for all court proceedings.
