

1 **LR12-201. Electronic filing authorized.**

2 [Related Statewide Rule 1-005.2 NMRA]

3 In accordance with Rule 1-005.2 NMRA, electronic filing is implemented for all civil,
4 habeas corpus, and probate actions in the Twelfth Judicial District Court as well as domestic
5 relations actions involving the New Mexico Child Support Enforcement Division. The electronic
6 filing of documents is mandatory for parties represented by attorneys in accordance with Rule 1-
7 005.2 NMRA, which includes attorneys who represent themselves. Guidelines for using the
8 electronic filing system are set forth in the court's user guide that is available in the clerk's office
9 and on the court's website.
