

1 **LR6-213. Electronic filing authorized.**

2 [Related Statewide Rule 1-005.2 NMRA]

3 In accordance with Rule 1-005.2 NMRA, electronic filing is implemented for all civil
4 [~~and probate~~] actions in the Sixth Judicial District Court as defined in Rule 1-005.2(B)(1)
5 NMRA, as well as domestic relations actions involving the New Mexico Child Support
6 Enforcement Division. The electronic filing of documents is mandatory for parties represented
7 by attorneys in accordance with Rule 1-005.2 NMRA, which includes attorneys who represent
8 themselves. Guidelines for using the electronic filing system are set forth in the court's user
9 guide that is available in the clerk's office and on the court's website.
