15                                           **ORDER**

16                   WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration upon recommendation of  
17 the Uniform Jury Instructions - Criminal Committee to adopt new UJI 14-631, 14-  
18 632, 14-633, 14-634, 14-5191A, and 14-6019C NMRA; to amend UJI 14-203, 14-  
19 252, 14-990, 14-2211, 14-2241, 14-5007, 14-5009, 14-5010, 14-5040, 14-5106, 14-  
20 5110, 14-5111, 14-5170, 14-5171, 14-5172, 14-5173, 14-5174, 14-5191, 14-6019,  
21 and 14-6019A NMRA; and to withdraw UJI 14-5002 and 14-5105 NMRA of the  
22 Uniform Jury Instructions – Criminal; and the Court having considered the  
23 recommendation and being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice Judith K. Nakamura,  
24 Justice Barbara J. Vigil, Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice C. Shannon Bacon, and  
25 Justice David K. Thomson concurring;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that new UJI 14-631, 14-632, 14-  
2 633, 14-634, 14-5191A, and 14-6019C NMRA are ADOPTED;

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amendment of UJI 14-203, 14-252, 14-  
4 990, 14-2211, 14-2241, 14-5007, 14-5009, 14-5010, 14-5040, 14-5106, 14-5110,  
5 14-5111, 14-5170, 14-5171, 14-5172, 14-5173, 14-5174, 14-5191, 14-6019, and 14-  
6 6019A NMRA is APPROVED;

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that UJI 14-5002 and 14-5105 NMRA are  
8 WITHDRAWN;

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that above-referenced amendments shall be  
10 **effective for all cases pending or filed on or after December 31, 2019;** and

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is authorized and  
12 directed to give notice of the above-referenced amendments by publishing them in  
13 the *Bar Bulletin* and *New Mexico Rules Annotated*.

14 IT IS SO ORDERED.
