



New Mexico Judicial Branch COVID-19 Court Facility Screening Questions
Employee – NOT Fully Vaccinated

A judicial officer or judicial employee is considered fully vaccinated when they are two weeks beyond their second Moderna or Pfizer vaccination or have received their Johnson and Johnson vaccination, and if eligible, must have received their COVID-19 Booster, as confirmed by submission or presentation of the judicial officer's or employee's vaccination card to human resources.

1. What is your work status today?
 - Teleworking
 - Working in the building
 - On leave – Please give the dates you will be on leave _____

2. Have you submitted your weekly test results in accordance with the FAQ's?
 - Yes - Please proceed to the next question*
 - No - You are not permitted to enter the building*

3. Have you been asked to self-quarantine because of COVID-19 and are you still within the quarantine period?
 - Yes - You are not permitted to enter the building*
 - No- Proceed to the next question*

4. Within the past seven (7) days, have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 by a doctor or received positive test results for COVID-19 from a testing center or by the Department of Health?
 - Yes- You are not permitted to enter the building*
 - No- Proceed to the next question*

5. Have you taken a COVID-19 test potential contact, or COVID-19 symptoms, and are still waiting for the test results?
 - Yes - You are not permitted to enter the building*
 - Yes - You have already completed a seven (7) day self-isolation period, AND you have the approval of your administrative authority. Proceed to the next question.*
 - No- Proceed to the next question*

6. In the past seven (7) days, have you been in contact with anyone who you know has COVID-19?
 - Yes - You are not permitted to enter the building*
 - No – Proceed to question #7*

7. Within the past five (5) days, have you had a fever at or above 100.4 degrees, chills, sore throat, body aches, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, headaches, developed new shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, dry cough, or loss of taste or smell?

- Yes - *You are not permitted to enter the building*
- No
- Other - *You have received written approval from your chief judge, administrative authority or designee to return to the court or facility OR You have received negative test results and symptoms have subsided; OR You have self-isolated for 7 days from the date the positive test was taken.*
