

## Juror Screening Questions as of 14 Oct 22

1. Within the past 5 days, have you had a fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, shortness of breath or fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea? If yes, please see Jury Services.
2. Within the past 5 days, have you tested positive for COVID-19? If yes, speak to Jury Services. Jurors should be discharged and recycled.
3. Have you taken a COVID-19 test and are still waiting for the test results? If yes, speak to Jury Services immediately. If yes, the juror may remain as long as they are masked and physically distanced and must inform Jury Services or the Court of a positive test result.
4. In the past 5 days, have you been in contact with anyone who you know has COVID-19 OR who is required to self-quarantine? Please see Jury Services. Juror is to be recycled. If yes, do not enter. Inform the juror they will be placed in the next jury pool.
